Bernatz advised the commission that the major equipment line item was budgeted to update the Mobile Command Center, but after talking with the vendor with the current supple shortage they are looking out two years on new orders. Bernatz would like to switch projects and use that money to purchase a thermal drone for Emergency Management. Bernatz provided spec sheets and price. Bernatz would use this drone for search and rescue, communications tower inspections, and damage assessment. Doreen Cook asked if we had applied for any grants to purchase this piece of equipment, Bernatz advised we had not but with the inability to get the Mobile Command Center built within the budget year there would be money in the budget to purchase this item. Mitchell and Dettmer suggested having Chickasaw County Rescue Squad purchase the drone and have a 28E between EMA and Rescue Squad. Mitchell also explained that COA was for public safety.
