The project is defined as PCC Overlay Project - On V18, from U.S. Hwy. 18 North approximately 8.6 miles to the South Corporate Limits of the City of Alta Vista; and WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting' and WHEREAS, the Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Chickasaw County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Board to accept the bid from Croell, Inc. in the amount of \$4,216,487.16 and awards to associated contract(s) to the same; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of the Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Chickasaw County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, Roman Lensing, the County Engineer for Chickasaw County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this County. Motion by Hackman, seconded by Suckow to approve RESOLUTION NO. 01-22-24-03 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A NEW MINIMUM REQUIRED BALANCE IN THE CHICKASAW COUNTY SANITARY LANDFILL ACCOUNTWHEREAS, Resolution No. 07-11-16-34 created a restricted fund titled "Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill Account" and established a minimum required balance of \$500,000.00 to be maintained in said account for potential costs associated with ongoing issues at the closed Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill—including maintaining and correcting water quality control, leachate control, methane gas control, and providing and maintaining

appropriate ground cover; and WHEREAS, a series of new actions to address leachate control and appropriate ground cover at the closed Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill are in the discussion and planning process; and WHEREAS, the costs associated with any new actions could be paid with funds set aside to address leachate control and appropriate ground cover at the closed Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill that currently are held in the Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill Account, but any payments from the restricted fund could drop the account balance below the minimum required balance of \$500,000.00. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chickasaw County Board of Supervisors hereby establishes a new minimum required balance of \$300,000.00 to be maintained in the Chickasaw County Sanitary Landfill Account.
